





Dr. Philip Hong is the Dean and Professor at UGA School of Social Work. Prior to joining UGA in July 2022, he served on faculty at Loyola University Chicago and Saint Louis University for the past 20 years where he served in many roles, including founding director of the Center for Research on Self-Sufficiency (CROSS). His main academic interest is in poverty and workforce development and his research program has focused on structural poverty and social exclusion. He has served as the principal investigator and consultant for various projects and international organizations. His research has been used to improve social service efficacy and inform social policy development/improvement. He is the developer of the Transforming Impossible into Possible (TIP) intervention model that applies the theory of psychological self-sufficiency to strengthen individuals' goal-directed process to reach success outcomes.
